## 7. Other Business

The meeting passed a vote of thanks to Fred for his work as organizer of MODSIM 2001. The vote was carried by acclamation.

### Conference Content

- A new session explicitly on the IMPACT of modelling would be useful.
- A 3<sup>rd</sup> class of papers (in addition to keynote and short/sharp), eg synthesis papers which would be twice as long as standard papers. These may compare approaches, encompass several themes, etc.
  - Fred Ghassemi, MODSIM 2001 convenor, noted that MODSIM 2001 did have some focused sessions.
  - David Post, MODSIM 2003 convenor, indicated that 20 minutes were locked in so that participants could move between papers. However, a few panel/discussion sessions could be accommodated.
- A new session on not what the models were, but the problems encountered would be useful. (David indicated that would simply need another session organizer!)

### Conference Publicity

- For someone for whom modeling is not a core activity (and therefore MODSIM is not their 'regular' conference, more targeted publicity is required, say directed towards disciplines such as geomorphology, faculties, newsletters.
- Action: The President asked members to email him of other societies/groups so that MSSANZ could expand the MODSIM mailing list.

### Conference Proceedings

There was extensive discussion on whether proceedings should be on CD – only, as alternative to paper, or in addition to paper. MODSIM 2003 convenor, David Post, indicated that registrants would be invited to indicate on registration brochure, and via the website, whether they want CD or paper proceedings. Individual papers will definitely be posted to the website in pdf format 3 weeks before the conference. Participants would then have option of getting proceedings or not.
