UNSW Climate Change Research Centre postdoc positions

The CCRC is a multi-disciplinary climate research centre comprising one of the largest university research facilities of its kind in Australia.

Postdoc 1: The Research Associate will work on an ARC-funded project to characterise extreme wind gusts in Australia. This project seeks to better understand and predict wind gusts and their impacts to aid in planning. The Research Associate will help address these questions by examining meteorological data and regional climate simulations, and/or by conducting a variety of regional and local-scale numerical weather simulations to improve our understanding of gust generation and impacts.

Postdoc 2: The Research Associate will conduct research focused on the development and/or application of the Community Atmosphere Biosphere Land Exchange (CABLE) land model. This is the land surface scheme used in the Australian Community Climate and Earth Simulator (ACCESS) model which is a collaboration between the ARC Centre of Excellence for Climate Extremes, CSIRO and the Bureau of Meteorology.
