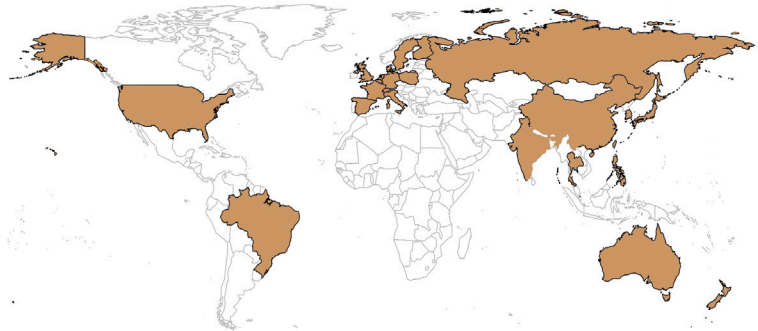

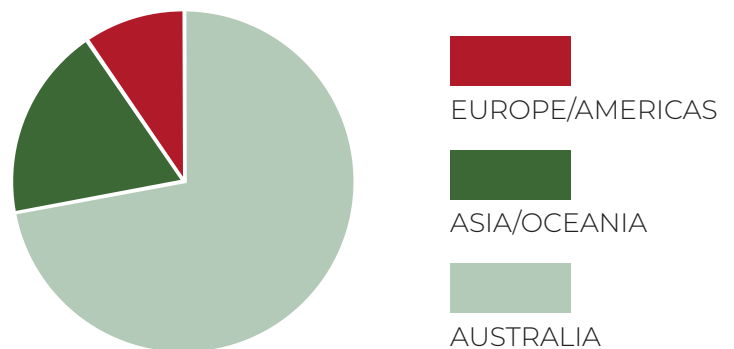

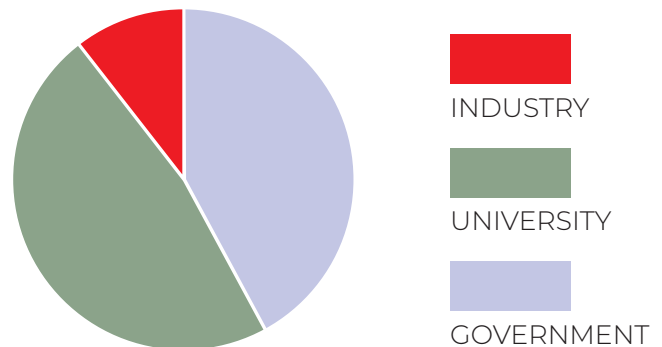
Attendees from 27 countries at MODSIM 2021 and 2023
